I will always remember the day I got a call from our state board chair Bob Moss stating that he and the board wanted me to take some sabbatical time for the purpose of rest and recovery. In my 40 plus years in ministry, never have I had a board that was proactive in looking out for my well-being and that took the initiative for sabbatical rather than my having to do so. I can't express enough my sentiments of gratitude to the good board that governs the work of Ohio Ministries; Bob Moss (central), Jim Roma (Northeast), Faye Goode (Northeast), Steve Rauch (Southeast), Erik Spohr (Southwest), C.J. Plogger (Central) and David Grogg (Northwest). Together the board, I believe, saved me from an emotional collapse.

Pam and I were in California for a family funeral when we got the frantic call from our daughter informing us that our house was on fire. Now not only had we suffered a series of losses but also now we didn't even have a home to go back to. I was still mourning the death of my mother and dealing with the feelings of being orphaned due to the loss of my only parent since I was ten. Add to that the reality that we were now, in a matter of speaking, homeless as well. In addition to the emotional trauma we had experienced, I was tired, really tired, after eight years in state ministry and eventually ended up in the hospital on two different occasions.

I'm happy to say that I'm healthy once again, rested and ready to reengage. A part of what I want to do is to help other pastors and churches think and work through this whole matter of sabbatical. I know there are pastors in our state who are just weary from the work of ministry that is unceasing and unrelenting. If I/we as the staff of Ohio Ministries can assist you, please let us know.
